The purpose of this document is to authorize contracted employees of the Calapooia Watershed Council (Council) or its agents to enter or cross private property to conduct inventory and noxious weed removal activities (see section 1 below) and to absolve landowners from all liabilities related to actions conducted by the Council.

- This agreement is entered into to accomplish the following tasks:
 - Determine if invasive weeds are present and measure their extent
 - Facilitate knotweed control using hand removal or spot application of Rodeo or Aquamaster (glyphosate) and conduct revegetation of native plants as necessary
 - Provide access to work sites across owner's land by foot or vehicle
 - Allow project monitoring by the Council or its agents
- The work will occur on lands owned by the landowner at the above address(es) in Linn County, OR.
- Data about weed location and treatment may be included in a weed database for regional weed mapping and scientific analysis. However, landowner name and address will be kept separate and confidential so that it is not associated with weed data.
- The Council and its agents agree to hold landowners harmless for all claims, suits or actions of whatsoever nature resulting from this cooperative agreement.
- Permission is granted for 3 years or until formally revoked, either orally or in writing.
- This agreement shall be effective upon the signature of all the parties listed below.
